We've had a couple of units damaged due to water leaks in the last month. PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE turn your water OFF if you are leaving Edgewater for more than a day! The Board will be discussing potential ideas for reducing our liability where this damage is concerned. It is costly to everyone, and something as simple as turning your water off could reduce these costs and inconveniences for your neighbors. Thank you for your attention to this very serious matter.

We've recently had plumbing work done in the basement of the pool building. Thanks to all residents who were very patient the day we had the water turned off. Part of this work was the installation of a pressure-reducing valve. It is the opinion of the "experts" that part of the reason pipes and water tanks have been failing at a rapid rate is due to the excessive water pressure (which was almost double what it should be). As a result, you will be noticing a reduction in water pressure. Believe it or not, this is where it SHOULD be, but it is a significant difference from what it was. Please be patient and try to adapt to this appropriate level. We appreciate your cooperation, and hope that this modification will help with our water problems...however, this does not mean that other measures (such as replacing old tanks, pipes, valves, and turning off the water when away from Edgewater) should not be taken.
