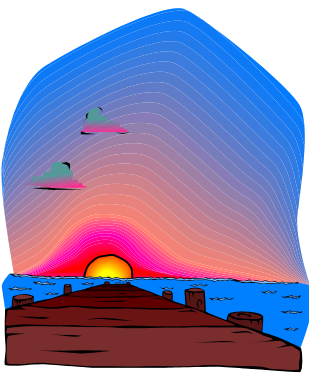

GREETINGS FROM EDGEWATER!

We are currently acquiring bids for sidewalk repairs, brick work on buildings where cracks are present, and office apartment stairs/deck.
