Project Updates:

Edgewater has been a busy place this summer, as we make improvements to the property. While we attempt to try to inform you of projects ahead of time, sometimes we get calls from contractors saying they can fit us in at the spur of the moment. Here are some of the projects underway:

- Roofs have been or are being replaced on N and L buildings and the shed.
- New building signs have been posted. These will give the complex a more consistent look and, more importantly, serve as better directions for visitors and emergency personnel. Signs have also been erected in parking areas and by the beach stairs. In addition, individual unit numbers are being replaced with the building and unit number to reflect the mailing address. We did run out of unit numbers and have ordered more, so if you still have an old number, it will be replaced.
- We are in the process of finding an insured contractor to clean up the basement in the pool building and remove scrap metal there and elsewhere on the grounds.
- The concrete stair pads at the office apartment and buildings F and J are scheduled to be repaired.
- The stairs to the office apartment are being replaced.
- Repairs to the drains near J and K buildings are being scheduled.
- Work is scheduled for mid-August to get rid of bats in F Building and make repairs to prevent them from re-entering.
- We are getting estimates on repairing the chimneys on D Building
- The landscape committee has been allocated \$2,000 to begin replacing bushes in buildings C through K.
