### **New Recycling Regulations**

Beginning Wednesday, September 5 the blue recycling barrels will be removed and ALL recyclable materials will be co-mingled into one dumpster.

Initially we will be utilizing the dumpster that has been used strictly for cardboard. That dumpster will be replaced with a larger one in the near future.

The rules will remain the same for all recyclables:

Bottles, cans, and plastic must be rinsed and clean.

Newspapers can go inside this dumpster.



Cardboard boxes must be broken down and collapsed as best possible. <u>This is important!</u> <u>The volume consumed by boxes will limit the area usable for other products, resulting in a call to the waste disposal company. This, in turn CO\$T\$ MONEY.</u>
